

## ***Suggested Restaurants***

### ***Downtown Denver***

1. **Mercantile Dining & Provision** (1701 Wynkoop Street at Union Station) – A signature take on elevated comfort food, the restaurant creates seasonally-inspired dishes and serving them in a casual dining atmosphere [Note: Union Station has a wide variety of quality restaurants, bars, and coffee shops.]
2. **Denver Milk Market** (1800 Wazee Street) – An all-local, all-wonderful mix of take-away and dine-in restaurants and bars. Denver Milk Market, a 16-venue cornerstone of the historic Dairy Block, draws in visitors, neighbors and fans to shop a little, drink a little, eat a little and celebrate a lot in the very heart of the Ballpark Neighborhood here in Denver.
3. **Bistro Vendome** (1420 Larimer Street) – A French restaurant on Larimer Street, Bistro Vendome is a traditional left bank-style cafe with a garden crafting slightly modern twists on French standards.
4. **Buckhorn Exchange** (1000 Osage Street) – Storied steakhouse where mounted game gaze on dishes of yak, ostrich, elk & Rocky Mountain oysters.
5. **STK** (1550 Market Street) – Sleek, clubby LoDo link in a national chain serving modern chophouse eats and drinks with a side of scene.
6. **Elway's Downtown** (1881 Curtis Street) – Former Denver quarterback's steakhouse namesake serves upscale cuts in a swanky space with a terrace.
7. **Marco's Coal Fired** (2129 Larimer Street) – Neapolitan pizzas handmade from imported Italian ingredients in rustic brick digs with a patio. It is certified by the Associazione Verace Pizza Napoletana, the only VPN certified pizzeria in the State of Colorado.
8. **Guard and Grace** (1801 California Street) – A modern high-design steakhouse by Chef / Owner Troy Guard, located on a busy corner site in Denver
9. **Sam's No. 3 Diner** (1500 Curtis Street) – A chain with a downtown restaurant that looks like a circa-1927 kitschy diner dishing up big helpings of comfort food from breakfast through dinner.
10. **Brass Tacks** (1526 Blake Street) – Another LoDo restaurant with an all-day menu that includes breakfast sandwiches and coffee, lunch options, happy hour specials, better-than-bar dinner food, and all manner of cocktails.
